

Our history

From distinguished beginnings ...

As a forward-thinking publisher for the past 175 years, Macmillan has always been passionate, supportive and innovative.

When brothers Daniel and Alexander Macmillan founded their publishing company in 1843, they created a

place that would recognise and value great contemporary writing. They made a mark on the literary world, publishing an extraordinary range of works by extraordinary authors such as Thomas Hardy and Rudyard Kipling to name a few.

... into Africa

When former British Prime Minister, Harold Macmillan, became chairperson in the middle of the 20th century, he decided that education should be a key investment area of the organisation. With his vision, the company established itself as a world leading educational publisher with an outstanding reputation. His famous 'Winds of Change' tour of Africa in the 1960s not only changed the political face of Africa, but also provided the grand old man of publishing an opportunity to expand the Macmillan Publishing empire into Africa.





... and Eswatini

In the 1970s, the Government of Eswatini made a call for publishers to partner with His Majesty's government in providing technical assistance in publishing locally produced books that would suit the emaSwati. Macmillan was prepared to relocate to the country in order to provide the required services. At the time, the education system was heavily flooded with content from outside the nation's borders, which meant that emaSwati were learning content they could hardly relate to.

In 1979, the Swazi office commenced operations, staffed and run by local people. Locally, the company exists

in two parts: there is Macmillan Eswatini National Publishing Company (MENP), which exclusively focuses on producing learning materials for the state-funded free primary education (FPE). Over the years, a few subjects offered at junior secondary level have also been incorporated into the programme. The company works closely with the Government of Eswatini, through the Ministry of Education and Training (MoET) and the National Curriculum Centre (NCC). The other part is Macmillan Education Eswatini (MEE), which focuses on producing pro-Macmillan titles which are sold to booksellers, who then avail the material to the general public.

Now part of a much bigger publishing picture ...

Over the years the structure of the Macmillan publishing group has shifted to expand in different sectors and markets. Today Macmillan Education is part of Springer Nature, created in May 2015 when the

majority of Macmillan Science and Education formally merged with Springer Science, Business Media, and the Nature Group to become the largest academic publishing company in the world.

Macmillan Education Eswatini is at the forefront of innovation, supporting the transition of the traditional Eswatini classroom into a blended learning environment – offering print products.

Our specialised publishing teams work with respected Eswatini authors and educationalists in order to develop and evaluate materials of the highest standard and quality that enhance the teaching and learning experience for everyone – whether it is a child in a Grade R classroom reading his first word, a teacher teaching Form five, or even a college student.


